The **GLENN CARLSON** Distinguished Service Award

This award is named after Glenn Carlson who was the Executive Director of the St Cloud Area Chamber of Commerce for 33 years. He was a founder of the Mn. Baseball Amateur Baseball Hall of Fame and served as it's 1st secretary for 35 years. He was inducted into the Mn Amateur Baseball Hall of Fame in 1980.

Purpose: The Glenn Carlson Distinguished Service Award is given to an individual who has made special meritorious contributions to furthering the promotion of Minnesota Amateur Baseball. This award was established to recognize individuals whose actions have brought outstanding positive recognition to Minnesota Amateur Baseball.

Eligibility defined: The candidate's greatest contribution to Minnesota Amateur Baseball was made in areas such as (but not limited to): media, board members, umpires, authors, financial supporter, or local, regional or state workers. Candidates may or may not have been a player, coach or manager. The candidate may have been paid for his or her service, but he or she has gone above and beyond assigned paid duty of the good of amateur baseball in Minnesota.

Nomination Procedure and Requirements:

- 1. Complete the 'Glenn Carlson Distinguished Service Award' form. (Copies may be obtained from the secretary of Hall of Fame or downloaded from the Web Site.)**
 - a. Anybody may obtain a Nomination Form and nominate somebody they think is worthy of this award. League, sections and regions are encouraged to nominate individuals.**
 - b. All applications must be received by June 1st of each year to be considered.**
 - c. A minimum of 10 testimonials/nominations are needed for a candidate to be considered.**
- 2. The Selection Committee will review Nominations Forms annually and may select a maximum of (2) recipients from the applications received. (Applications will begin with the 2020 Year)**
- 3. If a nominee is not selected, Nomination Forms submitted on his/her behalf will remain on file and will be used again to support a nomination form for that person that in subsequent years.**
- 4. A Glen Carlson Distinguished Service Award selection committee shall be appointed by the HOF President to choose recipient(s).**
- 5. A Plaque will be given to recipient(s) at the annual banquet. A picture of selected award winner(s) will be displayed on year of presentation in museum. Their name(s) will also be inscribed by year on a permanent plaque in the museum together with all other Glenn Carlson Distinguished Service *Award winners*.**
